KCare is provided to parents who require a full-day service for their child. KCare provides care services, and time and space for children to play, explore and discover through specially designed environments with carefully chosen resources.



KCare aims to provide opportunities for children to develop confidence in communicating with others, social skills, self-help skills and values such as responsibility, care and respect.



KCARE FEE

Monthly fee for KCare in 2023

Singapore Citizen	Singapore Permanent Resident
\$210 (Fee after \$150 basic subsidy)	\$360

Fee payment by the 5th of each month.

A late payment charge of **3% per day** shall be levied for fee received after the 5th of each month.

Children who are on subsidy scheme will have <u>to fulfill a</u> <u>minimum attendance of at least one day a month</u>, to be entitled to the subsidy, or the subsidy shall be recovered from parents.
